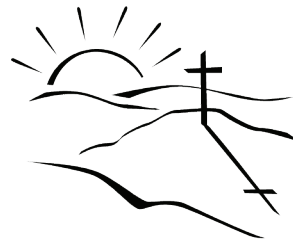

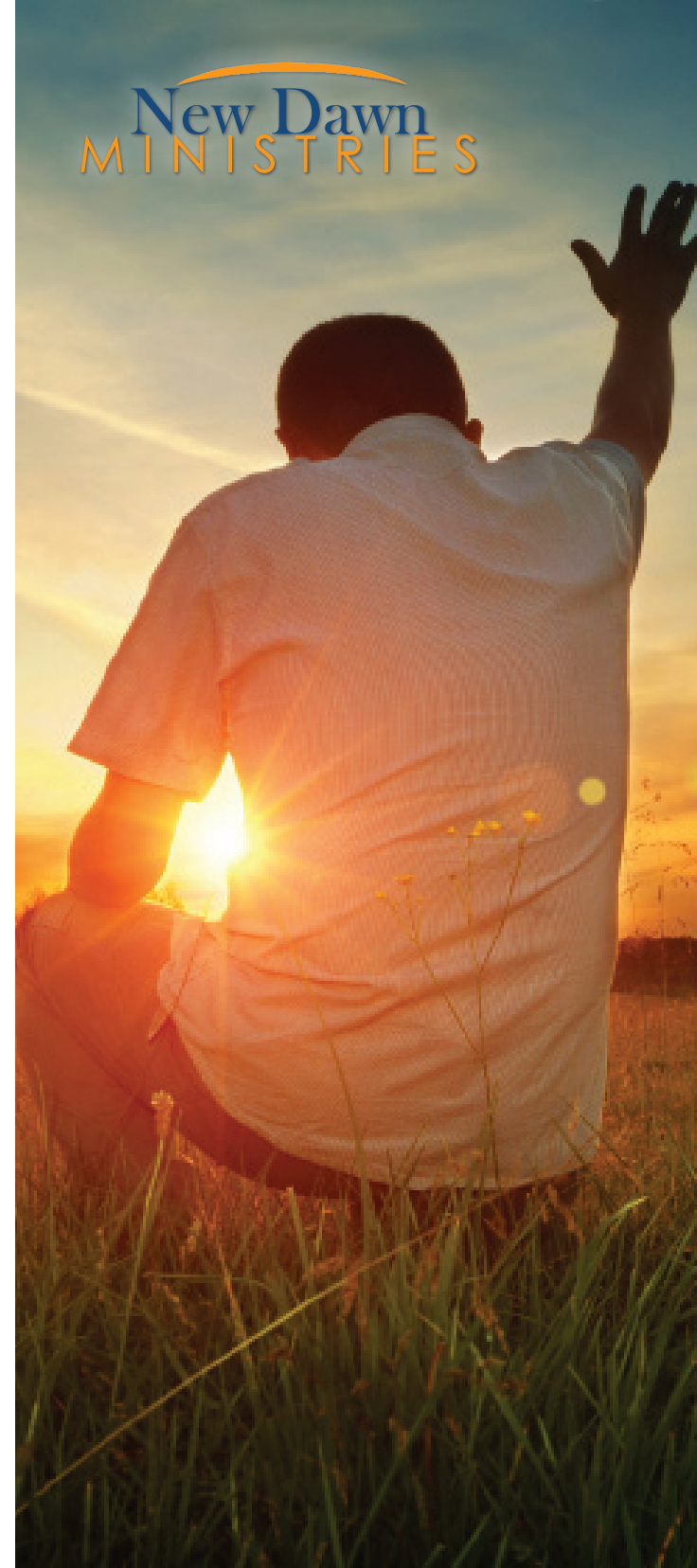

A Perspective on Deliverance

In a multitude of ways God offers deliverance to his children, including in the spirit, in the physical, and in the soul (1 Thess. 5:23). We receive freedom through salvation in Christ (Col.1:13), when we pray and when we worship, and as we become transformed through renewal of our minds (Rom. 12:2). With regard specifically to spiritual oppression, the body can be affected (e.g. Matt. 9:33), but it is over the soul (i.e. mind, will, and emotions) that the battles become fiercest.

Whether young or old, our spiritual adversary attempts to exploit every opportunity, loophole and legal right to torment and press his advantage. Strongholds can be formed through sin and breaking God's commandments – willfully or in ignorance (Lev. 5:17). Victimization, trauma or curse passed down the generational line can also place us at risk of oppression.

Because of Jesus' death on the cross and triumphant resurrection three days later, not only are we able to receive salvation and forgiveness of sin, but also healing (Isa. 53:5). God loves to deliver his people. He did it through Moses, Gideon and Esther; and now even more so through his Son. What astonishingly great news that God's gift of deliverance is still available today!
